## 2. DEFINITIONS

Personal data: data relating to the data subject – particularly the name, tax identification number or details about the physical, physiological, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of the data subject –, as well as conclusions drawn therefrom regarding the data subject;

Data subject/User: any natural person identified or – directly or indirectly – identifiable by specific personal data;

### 3. RANGE OF USERS

#### 13. COOKIES

### Right to request information
